

Municipal Building, Lodi, Cal., August 31, 1916.

Pursuant to adjournment of August 30th the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi convened at 10 a. m., there being present Trustees Hale, Black, Keeney, Deaver and Folendorf.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The matter of the employment of a special attorney to assist in the completion of the proposed city charter was taken up and discussed with City Attorney Steele.

It was moved by Trustee Deaver, seconded by Trustee Keeney, that it is the sense of this Board of Trustees that ample provision has already been made for the legitimate expenses of the Board of Freeholders. The motion carried unanimously.
