

Municipal Building, Lodi, Cal., Sept. 4, 1916.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi convened in regular session at 8:00 p.m. There were present Trustees Hale, Black, Keeney, Deaver and Folendorf.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Trustee Keeney moved, seconded by Trustee Black, that the tax rate for 1916 be fixed at \$1.00, apportioned as follows: For Bond Interest and Redemption Fund 37¢; Library Fund 13¢; General Fund 50¢. The motion carried by the following vote:

Ayes—Trustees Keeney, Black, Deaver, Hale and Folendorf.

Nays—None.

ORDINANCE NO. 87,

Entitled, "An Ordinance Levying Taxes in the Year 1916 in Provision of Revenue for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 1917," was introduced and read.

Trustee Deaver moved, seconded by Trustee Keeney, the adoption of the ordinance as read, which motion was carried by the following vote:

Ayes—Trustees Deaver, Keeney, Black, Folendorf and Hale.

Nays—None.

This date being a legal holiday and the Board having convened for the sole purpose of fixing the tax rate in compliance with law no further business was taken up. The Board adjourned to meet again at 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 5, 1916.
