

Public Hall, Lodi, California. Jan. 31, 1912.

In adjourned regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following trustees being present: J.M. Blodgett, F.O. Hale, G.E. Lawrence, C.A. Rich and L. Villinger. President Lawrence presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of Jan. 29, 1912, were read and approved.

Consideration of the bids received for fire hose was taken up, and the various samples inspected.

The executive committee of the Lodi Volunteer Fire Company recommended the "Cracker Jack" brand submitted by American Rubber Mfg. Co.

It was moved by Trustee Blodgett, seconded by Trustee Hale, that the bid of American Rubber Manufacturing Company of \$.85 per foot for "Cracker Jack" Hose be accepted for 1000 feet; that all ~~at~~ other bids be rejected; and that the certified check be returned to the unsuccessful bidders, which motion was carried by unanimous vote.


The consideration of bids for pipe was taken up.

It was moved by Trustee Rich, seconded by Trustee Blodgett, that the bid of Beckman, Welch & Thompson Company of \$289.15 be accepted, all other bids rejected, and the certified check returned to the unsuccessful bidders, which motion was carried by unanimous vote.

It was moved by Trustee Hale, seconded by Trustee Rich, that we furnish water to City Street Improvement Company for \$75.00 for the job.
