

Public Hall, Lodi, California, Feb. 14, 1912.

In adjourned regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following members of the Board being present: J.M. Blodgett, F.O. Hale, G.E. Lawrence, C.A. Rich and L. Villinger.

President Lawrence presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of Feb. 13, 1912, were read and approved.

The consideration of the bids for the construction of a municipal building was taken up.

It was moved by Trustees Hale, seconded by Trustee Blodgett, that the bid of W.D. Voorhies & Son, not being accompanied by a certified check in the amount of 10% of the bid nor by a sample of the brick to be used, as required by the specifications, be declared irregular and not a legal bid and be rejected, which motion was carried by the affirmative votes of Trustees Blodgett, Hale, Lawrence, Rich and Villinger.

It was moved by Trustee Rich, seconded by Trustee Villinger, that the municipal building be constructed of brick, which motion was carried by the affirmative votes of Trustees Blodgett, Rich, and Villinger; Trustee Hale voting no.

It was moved by Trustee Blodgett, seconded by Trustee Hale, that all bids, except the bid of C.I. Rice for brick construction, be rejected, which motion was carried by the affirmative votes of Trustees Blodgett, Hale, Lawrence, Rich and Villinger.

It was moved by Trustee Villinger, seconded by Trustee Rich, that the bid of C.I. Rice of \$3998.00, for brick construction, be accepted and the contract awarded to C.I. Rice, which motion was carried by the affirmative votes of Trustees Blodgett, Hale, Lawrence, Rich and Villinger.

On motion of Trustee Rich, seconded by Trustee Hale, the bond of C.I. Rice for the faithful performance of the contract was fixed at \$2000.00.

Ordinance No. 58, entitled, "An Ordinance Imposing Municipal Licenses on Social Clubs in the City of Lodi, California, Providing the Manner of Issuing, Collecting and Revoking the Same, Regulating the Sale of Liquor in Such Clubs, and Fixing a Penalty for the Violation of Said Ordinance", was read by the Clerk.

It was moved by Trustee Hale, seconded by Trustee Villinger, that the ordinance be adopted as read.

It was moved by Trustee Blodgett, seconded by Trustee Rich,
that the motion to adopt lay on the table for not less than five days,
which motion was carried by unanimous vote.

The Board adjourned.
