

Municipal Building, Lodi, California, Jan. 20, 1913.

In regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following trustees being present: F. C. Hale, G. E. Lawrence and C. A. Rich. Absent: Trustees C. A. Black and J. M. Blodgett. President Lawrence presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of Jan. 13, 1913, were read and approved.

The following applications for building permits were read and granted:

Catholic Church, church on lot 5 block 5;

The application of the Trustees of the Lodi School District for permission to discharge the water from Emerson School roof into the sewer on Hutchins Street was read and laid on the table.

W. P. Boden started a discussion of the matter of supplying water and sewer lines to the northern part of the town. The matter was referred to Public Utilities Committee.

An able report from City Engineer McAfee on the result of his investigations in regard to the boundary of the old townsite of Mokelumne, and determining that there was no roadway or street along the east boundary, was read and accepted.

Ordinance No. 66.

Ordinance No. 66, fixing rates for electric lighting, was read and, on motion of Rich, seconded by Hale, introduced and laid on the table for not less than five days pursuant to adoption.

GRADE MAP.

City Engineer McAfee presented a map entitled, "Official Map of the City of Lodi, San Joaquin County, California, Showing Curb and Gutter Grades, Water Mains and Hydrants, Sewer Connections and Boundaries of Fire Districts".

On motion of Trustee Rich the map aforesaid was ordered filed.

ORDINANCE NO. 67.

Ordinance No. 67, establishing grades of the curbs and gutters of the streets in the City of Lodi, was read and introduced, and, on motion of Rich, seconded by Hale, laid on the table for not less than five days exclusive of the day of introduction.

On motion, the Board adjourned until Jan. 27, 1913, at the usual hour and place.
