

Municipal Building, Lodi, California, Jan. 27, 1913.

In adjourned regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following trustees being present: C.A. Black, J.M. Blodgett, F.C. Hale, G.E. Lawrence and C.A. Rich. President Lawrence presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of Jan. 20, 1913, were read and approved. The following applications for building permits were read and granted:

C. LeVere, dwelling at 309 Tokay St.;
J.L. Pickering, remodelling front at 122 N. Sac. St.

The application for permission to connect the roof of the Emerson School with the city sewer was taken up, and the President stated that any motion to grant the request would be ruled out of order as the property is outside the city limits.

ORDINANCE NO. 66.

Ordinance No. 66, entitled, "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 47, entitled, "An Ordinance Providing Regulations for the Municipal Light Works, and Fixing Rates for Light and Power", having been introduced on Jan. 20, was read and placed on passage.

It was moved by Rich, seconded by Blodgett, that Ordinance No. 66 be adopted as read, which motion was carried and the ordinance adopted by the following vote: Ayes: Black, Blodgett, Hale, Lawrence and Rich. Noes: None.

ORDINANCE NO. 67.

Ordinance No. 67, entitled, "An Ordinance Adopting An Official Map of the City of Lodi, and Establishing the Grades of the Curbs and Gutters of the Streets in the City of Lodi, California", having been read and introduced on Jan. 20, 1913, was read and placed on passage.

It was moved by Rich, seconded by Blodgett, that Ordinance No. 67 be adopted as read, which motion was carried and the ordinance adopted by the following vote: Ayes: Black, Blodgett, Hale, Lawrence and Rich. Noes: None.

ORDINANCE NO. 68.

Ordinance No. 68, establishing a Board of Health, was read and introduced, and on motion of Rich, seconded by Black, laid on the table for not less than five days exclusive of the day of introduction.

ORDINANCE NO. 69.

Ordinance No. 69, providing for the enforcement of the rules and regulations of the Board of Health, was read, and introduced, and, on motion of Blodgett, seconded by Hale, laid on the table for not less than five days exclusive of the day of introduction.


ORDINANCE NO. 70.
