The applications of G.E. Henton and A.C. Sandner were referred to Street Committee.

A communication from Anti-alien Land League, asking the Board to pass a resolution favoring the passage of a bill prohibiting the alien ownership of land in California, was read and a ruling made by the chair that such resolution would be out of order.


F.L. Marchand took up the matter of opening an alley way through block 50. The matter was referred to Public Utilities Com.

On motion, the Board adjourned until April 14, 1913, at the usual hour and place.


