

Municipal Building, Lodi, California, May 19, 1913.

In regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following trustees being present: C.A. Black, J.M. Blodgett, F.O. Hale, G.E. Lawrence and C.A. Rich. President Lawrence presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of May 12, 1913, were read and approved.

The following applications for Building Permits were read and granted:

J.J. Pimm, iron gate and roof on lots 11 & 12 of block 28;  
A. Soucie, dwelling at cor. of Pine St. & Cherokee Lane.

It was moved by Rich that Mr. John Bauer be informed that the Board is in favor of allowing the sum of \$10.00 for each band concert of two hours duration, one each week for ten weeks. Carried.

Claims against the City aggregating the sum of \$323.50, having been approved by the Finance Committee, were allowed and ordered paid.

The matter of an inspector of electric wiring was taken up, and J.B. Bushnell who was present suggested that it would be advisable to have one, inasmuch as much of the work in the city was skimped on account of competition being keen. Referred to Committee of the Whole.

On motion, the Board adjourned until May 26, 1913, at the usual hour and place.
