

Municipal Building, Lodi, California, June 9, 1913.

In adjourned regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following trustees being present: C.A. Black, F.O. Hale, G.E. Lawrence and C.A. Rich. Absent: J.M. Blodgett. President Lawrence presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of June 2, 1913, were read and approved.

A communication from Geo. E. Henton, complaining of the treatment that he claimed he had received at the hands of the City, was read and referred to Public Utilities Committee.

A communication from Wm. Dolge was read and ordered filed.

A communication from W.E. Lucas asking for a permit to conduct a boxing tournament in Lodi was read and filed.

A communication from H.H. Henderson in regard to Holt claim was read and referred to Finance Committee.

The following applications for Building Permits were read and granted:

- F.G. Cary, 3 story brick bldg. at cor. Pine and School Sts.;
- Henary Morrow, dwelling on lot 4 block 5 Barnhart Tract;
- Morehead Lumber Co., barn on lots 13, 14 & 15 block 26;
- R. Lee & J. Prentice, dance plat-form on lot 5 block 13.

Trustee Black of P.U. Com. reported no action on St. Light. granted further time. Also reported that people on S. School St. wanted sewerage. Referred back to P.U. Com.

On motion, of Hale Clerk was instructed to get copies of ordinances regulating every little movement in dancing.

Engineer McAfee was granted a couple of days leave of absence on account of sickness.

Chairman Rich of Building Com. reported that they had quotations from Builders' Iron Works on the following for jail: 3-2x1'6"- $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron screens; 2-3x6"- $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron; wds.; 1-5x2"- $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron vent.; 1-3x2'8" iron trans.; 3-2x6"- $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron doors per cut; 3 swinging bunks; 1 corridor bunk. Total price for all \$192.00.

On motion of Black, seconded by Hale, the Building Com. was authorized to purchase the material.


Various claims against the City aggregating the sum of \$2471.31 were approved by the Finance Committee, allowed and ordered paid.
