Feb. 18, 1910.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi convened in adjourned regular session pursuant to adjournment of Feb. 14th., 1910, President G.E. Lawrence presiding and the following other members of the Board being present: J.M. Blodgett, F.O. Hale, C.A. Rich and L. Villinger.

The Minutes of the Previous Meeting were read and approved.

F.G. Cary asked about the matter of connecting up with new consumers. It appeared to be the sense of the Board that connections be made as in the past at the same charges, and that any loss to Cary Brothers be charged to the City. In regard to installing meters on new light consumers it seemed to be the sense of the Board that meters be put on, and if new meters had to be purchased, the bills for the same be turned over to the City.

Engineer H.H. Henderson was present, and stated that he was worn out and had not gotten the plans in shape to present at this time, but would have them to-morrow night.

It was moved and seconded that this Board do now adjourn to meet Thursday evening, Feb. 17, 1910, at the usual hour and place. Carried and so ordered.
