In adjourned regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following Trustees being present: J.M. Blodgett, C.A. Rich and H. Villinger. Absent: President Lawrence, Trustee Hale and City Clerk J.M. McMahon.

Trustee J.M. Blodgett acted as President Pro Tem. and C.A. Rich as City Clerk Pro Tem.

The Minutes of the Previous Meeting were read and approved.

The following Applications for Building Permits were read and granted.

Alex A. Walter, Dwelling on Lot 3, Block 6, Barnhart Tract.


R.A. Buchanan, Dwelling on Lot 2, Block 2, East Lodi.

A Warrant in the sum of \$ 2497.39 was ordered drawn on the City Treasurer in favor of the First National Bank of Lodi, the said sum being the final payment due Appleton & Frederickson Bros. for constructing the Lodi Sewer System, exclusive of the 25% reserve. ( This sum to be drawn from Municipal Fund No. 1. )

A Committee from the Merchants Association waited on the Board and urged that steps be taken to furnish the City with adequate fire protection. The matter was referred back to the Association with the request that they perfect their suggestions.

The Board then adjourned to meet Thursday Oct. 27, 1910.
