The minutes of the meeting of Jan. 16th., 1911, were read and approved.

The following applications for Building Permits were read and granted:
W.O. Corbin, Wood shed for Robt. Boyce;
E.E. Breitenbucher, Garage on lot 9 Block 1, W. Lodi.

The application of James Marlow for permission to lay his own sewer pipe was read, and the Clerk was instructed to have the application and make proper application and file bond before issuing license.

J.W. Dougherty stated that he thought his light bill was too high. No action.

Wm. Lupton asked for information as to his sewer connections. He was referred to the Plumbing Inspector.


