

Public Hall, Lodi, California, Mar. 6, 1911.

In regular session of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, the following trustees being present: J.M. Blodgett, F.O. Hale, G.E. Lawrence, C.A. Rich and L. Villinger. President Lawrence presiding.

The Minutes of the meeting of Feb. 27, 1911, were read and approved.

The reports of the City Marshal and of the City Poundmaster for the month of Feb. were read and approved.
