Moved by F. O. Hale, seconded by L. Villinger that the Bond of City Treasurer be fixed at Six Thousand Dollars. Carried and so ordered.

Moved By C. A. Rich, seconded by J. M. Blodgett that the Bond of the City Marshall be fixed at Two Thousand Dollars. Carried and so ordered.

Moved by F. O. Hale, seconded by J. M. Blodgett. That ordinance No. 1 be adopted as read. Comes by the following vote: Ayes; Hale, Blodgett, Rich and Villinger. Nos; none. So ordered.
