

Public Hall, Lodi, California, Oct. 11, 1907

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi convened in adjourned regular session pursuant to adjustment of Oct. 7, 1907. The following Trustees being present; J. M. Blodgett, F. O. Hale, C. A. Rich, and L. Villinger.

Absent: G. E. Lawrence.

On motion regularly made, seconded and carried J. M. Blodgett was elected President Pro-Tem.

The Minutes of the meeting of Oct. 7, 1907 were read and approved as read.

The application of H. C. Haslam for a Building Permit was read and granted.

A petition asking for a street light at the Corner of Lockeford and Church St., was read and laid on the table.

The following resolution was then introduced and on motion regularly made, seconded and carried, the Resolution was unanimously adopted:

“Whereas, the Angel of Death had invaded the family circle of our Honored President, removing from earthly life to the glories of Paradise beyond, Mrs. Katherine Jones, the beloved mother of Mrs. George E.
