

Public Hall, Lodi, California, Aug. 3, 1908

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi convened in the regular session, President G. E. Lawrence presiding and the following other members of the Board being present: F. O. Hale, C. A. Rich, Leon Villinger. Absent: Jms. Blodgett

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The usual order of business was then dispensed with and F. E. Quail made a proposition to the Board as follows, That he had 400 unmounted maps of the City and 100 mounted maps, and that he would sell the entire number to the City for \$250 which figure was about the cost to him. The matter was taken under advisement.
