Pursuant to adjournment from the preceeding day, the Board of Trustees met at 7.30 P.M. in regular adjourned session, all members present; Trustee Shattuck presiding.

The Board proceeded to the consideration of the tax rate for the ensuing year and after estimating bulk expenditures from tax income sources, fixed the rate at \$1.70 per hundred by the passage of Ordinance No. 142, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE YEAR 1923 IN PROVISION OF REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1st., 1924". Said ordinance was approved, passed and adopted by the following vote:-

In the matter of the approval of the work and the assessment therefore on Hutchins-Walnut Street, Resolution of Intention No. 61: It appearing that such matters as needed remedy had been properly attended to, the assessment was approved and the warrant allowed the contractor by the passage of Resolution No. 416 as filed in the office of the City Clerk, by the following vote:-
