

ORDINANCE NO. 1023

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING AN APPROXIMATELY 9.5 ACRE PARCEL ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF EAST PINE STREET, 330 FEET EAST OF CLUFF AVENUE (i. e., LOT 10, LIVE OAK COLONY NO. 3) FROM THE I-PA, INTERIM-PROTECTIVE AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT (COUNTY DESIGNATION) TO THE M-2 HEAVY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (CITY DESIGNATION)

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 27-2 of the Code of the City of Lodi is hereby amended and the property hereinafter described rezoned and reclassified from its present classification as being I-PA, Interim-Protective Agricultural District (County Designation) to be in the M-2, Heavy Industrial District (City Designation), viz:

Lot 10 of Live Oak Colony #3 (i. e., San Joaquin County Assessor's Parcel # 049-09-08)


Section 2. The alterations, changes and amendments of the official District Map of the City of Lodi herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearings held in conformance with the provisions of Chapter 27 of the Code of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
