

ORDINANCE NO. 1122

ORDINANCE AMENDING OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING PARCEL AT 1720 S. HUTCHINS STREET, LODI FROM R-1, SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL TO R-MD, MEDIUM DENSITY MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 27-2 of the Code of the City of Lodi is hereby amended and the property hereinafter described rezoned and reclassified from its present classification as being in the R-1, Single-Family Residential to R-MD, Medium Density Multiple Family Residential, viz:

Parcel located at 1720 S. Hutchins Street, Lodi.

The alterations, changes, and amendments of said Official District Map of the City of Lodi herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearings held in conformance with provisions of Chapter 27 of the Code of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable thereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and

after its passage and approval.
