AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO DRINK OR HAVE AN OPEN CONTAINER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IN CERTAIN PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE CITY OF LODI.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. No person shall drink or have in his possession an open container of any alcoholic beverage:

- (1) On any public street, sidewalk, or other public way;
- (2) Within 50 feet of any public way while on private property open to public view without the express permission of the owner, his agent, or the person in lawful possession thereof.

Section 2. Violation of this ordinance is hereby declared to be an infraction.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be printed and published one time in the Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall become effective 30 days-from. and after its adoption.
