


ORDINANCE NO. 114.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE YEAR 1920 IN PROVISION OF
REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1921.



The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi do ordain as follows:

section 1. In the year 1929, and in provision of revenue for said city of Lodi for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1921, upon all the real and personal property within the City of Lodi taxable for municipal purposes there is hereby levied taxes as follows, to-wit:—

For the General Purposes of said City, at the rate of Eighty-five and Five-tenths Cents (\$0.855) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property;

For Library Purposes of said City at the rate of Seventeen Cents (\$0.17) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property;

For Bond Interest and Redemption purposes of said City, at the rate of Twenty-two and Five-tenths Cents (\$0.225) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property.

The aforesaid tax rate of Twenty-two and Five-tenths cents (\$0.225) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property is the rate for bond Interest and redemption on bonds of said City issued and outstanding on the 8th day of November, 1910, having been issued in the year 1908, and is apportioned as follows:

For interest and redemption on sewer bonds Nine Cents (\$0.09) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property.

For interest and redemption on water and light bonds Thirteen and Five-tenths cents (\$0.135) on each one hundred

dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Sentinel, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the said City of Lodi, and shall take effect thirty days from and after its passage, approval and publication.




