

ORDINANCE NO. 1164

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-6 OF  
THE LODI CITY CODE ENTITLED, "DUTIES,  
ETC., OF MAYOR AS PRESIDING OFFICER;  
MAYOR PRO TEMPORE"

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lodi as follows :


Section 1. The first sentence of Section 2-6 of the Lodi City Code is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

"The presiding officer of the Council shall be the Mayor who shall be elected annually on the Tuesday after the General Municipal Election and on the first regular meeting in April in the years when there is no General Municipal Election".

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
