

ORDINANCE NO. 127.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE YEAR 1921 IN PROVISION OF REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY FIRST, A.D. 1922.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF LODI DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

SECTION 1. In the Year 1921 and in provision of revenue for the said City of Lodi for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1922, upon all the real and personal property within said City taxable for municipal purposes there is hereby levied taxes as follows, viz:

For General Purposes of said City, at the rate of Eighty-four and fifty-eight one hundredths cents (\$0.8458) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property;

For Library Purposes of said City at the rate of Twenty cents (\$0.20) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property;

For Bond Redemption and Interest Purposes of said City, at the rate of Sixty and forty-two one hundredths cents (\$0.6042) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property.

The aforesaid tax rate of Sixty and forty-two one hundredths cents (\$0.6042) includes the rate for bond interest and redemption on bonds of the City issued and outstanding on the 8th day of November, 1910, having been issued in the year 1908, and the rate for said payments on said bonds is Twenty and sixteen one hundredths cents on each one hundred dollars of taxable property apportioned as follows:

For interest and redemption of sewer bonds, Eight cents (\$0.08) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property;

For interest and redemption of water and light bonds, Twelve and sixteen one hundredths cents (\$0.1216) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be published once in the "Lodi Sentinel", a newspaper of general circulation, printed and circulated in the City of Lodi, and shall take effect thirty days from and after its passage, approval and publication.
