

- ORDINANCE No, 149 -

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF THE CITY MARSHAL AND EX-OFFICIO SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 140 AS PASSED AND ADOPTED MAY 7TH, 1923.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF LODI DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. Ordinance No. 140 of the City of Lodi is hereby repealed.

Section 2. From and after the first day of July, 1925, the salary and allowances made the City Marshal and ex-officio Superintendent of Streets shall be as hereinafter set forth, the same to be in full for all services:-

For Salary as Marshal, the sum of \$ 125.00 monthly,

For Salary as Street Superintendent, the sum of \$ 75.00 monthly,

For use of his private automobile, the sum of \$25.00 monthly, the said sums of \$ 75.00 and \$25.00 to be in addition to the sum of \$ 125.00 to be paid him as Marshal.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News"


