



ORDINANCE No. 151

ORDINANCE GRANTING TO CENTRAL PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, A UTAH CORPORATION, AND SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, A KENTUCKY CORPORATION, THE FRANCHISE, RIGHT AND PRIVILEGE TO LAY DOWN, CONSTRUCT, RECONSTRUCT, RENEW, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE RAILROAD SPUR OR SIDE TRACKS TO SERVE LOCAL INDUSTRIES, UPON, ALONG AND ACROSS MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF LODI, COUNTY OF SAN JOAQUIN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AT ANY POINT OR POINTS BETWEEN LODI AVENUE AND ALMOND STREET AS NOW PLATTED AND SHOWN ON THE OFFICIAL MAPS OF SAID CITY OF LODI.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi do ordain
as follows:

1. The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, County of San Joaquin, State of California, hereby grants to CENTRAL PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a Utah corporation, and SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a Kentucky corporation, their successors and assigns, the perpetual franchise, right and privilege to lay down, construct, reconstruct, renew and maintain upon, along and across Main Street in the City of Lodi, at any point or points between Lodi Avenue and Almond street, as now platted and shown on the official maps of the said City of Lodi, railroad spur or aide tracks, with necessary switches, appendages and appurtenances, to serve local industries, and to operate thereon locomotives, trains and cars by steam, electricity or any other lawful motive power,
