

ORDINANCE No. 153

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE AND REPEALING THOSE PORTIONS OF EXISTING ORDINANCES IMPOSING A LICENSE TAX ON DOGS.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. - Ordinance No. 103 entitled " An Ordinance Amending Subdivision 9 of Section 14 of Ordinance No. 82, Providing for a License Tax on Dogs " which ordinance was finally passed, adopted and approved August 19th., 1918 is hereby repealed;

Section 2. - Section Six of Ordinance No. 6 as passed adopted and approved December 31st., 1906 is hereby amended to read as follows:-

It shall be unlawful for any person to own, harbor or have the care, custody, control or possession of any dog within the corporate limits of the City of Lodi, unless said dog shall at all times be kept securely inclosed in a building, pen or inclosure or unless said dog shall at all times be kept securely tethered.

It is hereby made the duty of the City Marshal, the Poundmaster or any person deputized by either of said officers to take up and impound any dog or dogs found running at large in any street, alley, court, square or public ground within the City of Lodi and to notify the owner or custodian of such dog, if known, that said dog may be redeemed at any time within three days from the date of such impounding or taking up, on payment of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) and 25 cents additional for each and every day said dog may have been kept in the City pound.

All dogs not redeemed as herein provided, shall be sold or if not sold, the same shall be killed by the City Marshal or the Poundmaster and buried at the expense of the City.
