

ORDINANCE NO. ~~161~~ 162

AN ORDINANCE SEPARATING THE DUTIES OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS OF THE CITY OF LODI AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE COMPENSATIONS.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1: The offices of Chief of Police and Superintendent of Streets of the City of Lodi shall not hereafter necessarily be held by the same person; but the City Council of the City of Lodi shall, from time to time, by resolution, appoint the Chief of Police of said city and the Superintendent of Streets of said city, and in making said appointments, may appoint the same person as Chief of Police and as Superintendent of Streets, or may appoint different persons to said respective offices, or may appoint the same person as Superintendent of Streets and as Chief of the Fire Department of said city.

Section 2: The Chief of Police shall receive for his services a monthly salary of \$ 200.00 ~~payable at the end of each and every month~~ and shall also receive, as compensation for the use of his automobile in his services as such Chief of Police, the sum of \$ 30.00 at the end of each and every month.

Section 3: The Superintendent of Streets shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of \$ 50.00 monthly and the further sum of \$25.00 monthly for the use of ~~his automobile~~. (his automobile.

Section 4: Any person who may hold the office of Superintendent of Streets, and who at the same time is holding the office of Chief of Police or Chief of the Fire Department, shall be entitled to collect from said city the salary and compensation for both offices, which such person may hereafter hold.

Section 5: The Chief of Police and the Superintendent of Streets, shall be appointed from time to time by resolution of said City Council, shall each hold office at the pleasure of said City Council and shall each be subject to removal from office at any time by said City Council with or without cause.

Section 6: Ordinance No. 149 approved July 6th., 1925 is hereby repealed.
