AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES IN THE YEAR
1929 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY,
1, 1929.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows :-

Section 1: Municipal taxes providing revenue for the fiscal year beginning July 1st., 1929 are hereby levied upon all real and personal property in the City of Lodi assessed for municipal purposes as of 12 o'clock Noon of the first Monday in March, 1929 as follows:-

For GENERAL FUND, at the rate of forty-five and one-half cents (45½¢) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property ;

For LIBRARY FUND, at the rate of twenty-four and one half cents (24½¢) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property ;

For BOND INTEREST AND REDEMPTION FUND, at the rate of fifty-five cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property ; the said rate of fifty-five cents including payments for redemption and interest on bonds issued and outstanding on the 8th day of November, 1910 apportioned as follows :

For Redemption and interest of SEWER BONDS of 1908 at the rate of four and one-half cents (4½¢); for redemption and interest of WATER AND LIGHT BONDS of 1908 at the rate of six and eight-tenths cents (6 8/10¢) on each one hundred dollars of the assessed value of said taxable property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in THE LODI SENTINEL, the official newspaper of said City and shall take effect and be in force in the manner and at the time provided by law.
