


An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 220 of the City of Lodi by Exempting Undertaking Establishments, Hospitals, Sanitariums and the Treatment of Sick Persons or Animals Therefrom.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows :

Ordinance No. 220 of the City of Lodi is hereby amended by adding thereto a section to be numbered "Section 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", which shall read, and said City Council does ordain, as follows :

"Section 8 $\frac{1}{2}$. The provisions of said ordinance No. 220 shall not apply to ~~any~~ person, firm, corporation or association conducting ~~or~~ to conduct any undertaking establishment, or place where sick or ailing persons ~~or~~ animals receive medical care, attention, nursing ~~or~~ hospitalization."

This ordinance shall be published once in the Lodi News-Sentinel, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Lodi, and this ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgent emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health of said city and shall be in force and effect immediately upon and after its final passage, approval and publication. The facts constituting such urgency are that said ordinance No. 220 does not except from the provisions thereof the businesses hereby excepted, but requires the same to be kept closed at certain times and it is urgently necessary that such businesses herein excepted be permitted to remain open and to transact such businesses at all times for the immediate preservation of the public health of said city.
