ORDINANCE NO. 263.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE  
NO. 218 OF THE CITY OF LODI, BY CHANGING  
SALARY OF THE CITY TREASURER AND EX-OFFICIO  
TAX COLLECTOR.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 218, entitled "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE CITY CLERK AND EX-OFFICIO ASSESSOR AND OF THE CITY TREASURER AND EX-OFFICIO TAX COLLECTOR OF THE CITY OF LODI, REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 112 and NO. 145 AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" is hereby amended to read as follows:


"Section 2. The City Treasurer and ex-officio Tax Collector of said City shall (from and after the expiration of the present term of office of said official) receive a salary of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00), per month for his services as such Treasurer and ex-officio Tax Collector, payable monthly, the salary of such officer, for term now unexpired, to remain as heretofore fixed."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this city and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its final passage and adoption.


