

ORDINANCE NO. 30

An ordinance levying the property taxes of the City of Lodi for the fiscal year of said City beginning July 1, 1908.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Upon and against all property in the City of Lodi which is taxable for State and County purposes under the Constitution and laws of the State of California, there is hereby levied, for the general purposes of the City of Lodi, a tax of *seventy five* cent5 upon each and every one hundred dollars in value of said property, the said tax hereby levied being the annual property tax of said City of Lodi for the fiscal year of said City beginning July 1, 1908.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published once in the *Lodi Sentinel*, a newspaper published in said City of Lodi, and shall have and take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a ^{regular adjourned} meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi on the 26th day of August, 1907, and was thereafter, at ^{adjourned} a regular meeting of said Board, on the ^{3rd day of} first Monday in September, 1907, ~~to wit, the second day of September, 1907,~~ passed and adopted by the following vote:
