ORDINANCE NO. 320,

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF
WELLSWOOD AVENUE AND OF A PUBLIC ALLEY IN BLOCK 4
OF " WELLSWOOD PARK " IN THE CITY OF LODI.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:


Section 1, After public hearings held before the City Planning Commission of the City of Lodi and before the City Council of said City, notice of said hearings having been given by publication and posting of notices thereof, the City Council hereby finds, determines and declares that the following described portion of a public street and all of a public alley, also hereinafter described, are unnecessary for present or prospective street purposes and hereby orders that the same be vacated, all in accordance with proceedings heretofore had in accordance with the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941 as amended, to wit:

THAT PART OF WELLSWOOD AVENUE LYING SOUTH OF THE NOW EXISTING SOUTH LINE OF MISSION STREET AS CONVEYED TO THE CITY OF LODI BY JOHANNA C. WELLS BROWN BY DEED DATED JANUARY 3, 1938 AND RECORDED JANUARY 12, 1938 IN OR 602/110, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY RECORDS, AND EXTENDING TO THE NORTH LINE OF CONCORD STREET.

ALL OF THE ALLEY RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH THROUGH BLOCK FOUR (4) IN WELLSWOOD PARK AS SHOWN ON THE OFFICIAL MAP THEREOF FILED AUGUST 20, 1924 IN VOL. 10, PAGE 93 OF MAPS AND PLATS, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY RECORDS.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time after its final passage and approval and shall be in force and take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law, The City Clerk shall cause a duly certified copy hereof to be filed in the office of the County Recorder of San Joaquin county.


