AH ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 238 (ZONING
ORDINANCE) BY ALTERING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF
CERTAIN ZONES AND RECLASSIFYING AND REZONING LOTS
NUMBERED FIVE (5) AND SIX (6) OF TRACT 21, LAKE
HOME SUBDIVISION

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as
follows:


Section 1. The Zone District Map of the City of Lodi,
adopted by Ordinance No. 238 as amended by Ordinance No. 270
adopted December 18, 1940 is hereby amended to the end that each
of Lots Five (5) and Six (6) in Lake Home Subdivision, Tract 21,
Subdivisions of San Joaquin County, shall, from the effective
date of this ordinance be reclassified and rezoned to be in the
Commercial District Zone as said zone is defined by the provisions
of Ordinance No. 238 of this City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one
time in the Lodi Times and shall take effect at the time and
in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances
in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in so far as such
conflict may exist.

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
