

ORDINANCE No. 37.

An Ordinance Amending Subdivision Three of Section One of Ordinance No. Two, Entitled, "An Ordinance Relating to the Licenses, License Tax Rates, and the Regulation of Certain Classes of Business and Certain Shows, Exhibitions and Lawful Games in the City of Lodi".

The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi do ordain as follows:

Section 1.- Subdivision Three of Section One of Ordinance Number Two, Ordinances of the City of Lodi, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Every person having a regular established place of business in the City of Lodi and every individual member of any firm, partnership, association or corporation having a regular established place of business in the City of Lodi, who, within the City of Lodi, sells, offers or solicits for sale or attempts to sell any real property not his own, the sum of \$5.00 per quarter. Itinerant agents or persons having no regular established place of business in the City of Lodi, the sum of \$15.00 per quarter each.

Section 2.- All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3.- This Ordinance shall be published once in the Lodi Sentinel, a newspaper published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
