ORDINANCE NO. 372

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I OF ORDINANCE NO. 287 ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 275 ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 250 RELATING TO AUTOMOBILE TRAFFIC ON
THE STREETS OF LODI'".

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. section 1 of Ordinance no. 287 entitled as set forth in
the title of this ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 1.
Ordinance No. 275, entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 250 Relating
to Automobile Traffic on the streets of Lodi" is hereby amended by adding thereto
a new paragraph following paragraph (i), said new paragraph to be lettered (j)
and to read as follows:


(j) When traveling in an Easterly or Westerly direction before
crossing the Easterly or Westerly property lines of Hutchins Street, provided that
at the intersection of Hutchins Street and West Pine street, automobile or
other traffic shall stop before entering West Pine street.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be published one time in "The Lodi
Times" and shall take effect on the erection of "Stop" signs required by Section
471 of the vehicle Code of this State at the street intersections designated
herein. This ordinance is a restatement and clarification of existing ordinances
providing added precautions against accidents at street intersections.


