ORDINANCE NO. 385

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 238 (ZONING ORDINANCE)
BY ALTERING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF CERTAIN ZONES
AS DISPLAYED ON THE " ZONE DISTRICT MAP OF THE
CITY OF LODI AND RECLASSIFYING AND REZONING
CERTAIN LOTS IN BLOCK 11, MOKELUMNE, NOW CITY
OF LODI, TO BE IN THE COMMERCIAL DISTRICT ZONE.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The " Zone District Map of the City of Lodi " adopted by
Section 2 of Ordinance No. 238 is hereby amended and the properties
hereinafter described, reclassified and rezoned from their present class-
ification as being in the Multiple Family Residence District Zone to
be in the COMMERCIAL DISTRICT ZONE. The properties herein rezoned are
particularly described as follows:

EACH OF LOTS ONE (1), TWO (2), THREE (3), SIX (6), SEVEN (7) AND
EIGHT (8) IN BLOCK ELEVEN (11) AS SAID LOTS AND BLOCK ARE DELINEATED AND
SO DESIGNATED ON THE OFFICIAL MAP ENTITLED MOKELUMNE, FILED AUGUST 25,
1869 IN VOL 2 OF MAPS, PAGE 12, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY RECORDS.

This amendment is made after hearings before the City Planning Comm-
ission and before the City Council of the City of Lodi in accordance with
the provisions of Ordinance No. 238 and of the Zoning Law of 1917 thereto
applicable.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith
are hereby repealed in so far as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in THE LODI TIMES
and shall take effect thirty days from and after its final passage and
approval.


