ORDINANCE NO. 393

REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 369 (IMPOSING RESTRICTIONS  
ON THE USE OF ELECTRIC ENERGY IN THE CITY OF LODI)

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 369 adopted March 31, 1948, effective immediately, is repealed.


The necessity for this ordinance no longer exists. The regulations and rules therein set forth for the conservation and curtailment of the use of electric energy as promulgated by the Emergency Power Director of the California Public Utilities Commission were withdrawn and cancelled July 1, 1949.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times and shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.


