ORDINANCE NO. 395

REGULATING THE INSTALLATION, OPERATION
AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRIC WIRING AND
ELECTRICALLY OPERATED APPLIANCES TO BE
CONNECTED THERETO BY ADOPTING A CODE
THEREFORE.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:


Section 1. The provisions of the UNIFORM ELECTRICAL CODE, published by the Pacific Coast Electrical Bureau, Edition of 1947, and each and every section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, including Appendix " A " , Appendix " B " and Appendix " C " are hereby adopted and shall obtain in all matters pertaining to the installation, operation and maintenance of electrical wiring and of all electrically operated appliances and devices connected thereto and therewith. Three copies of the said UNIFORM ELECTRICAL CODE have heretofore been filed with the City Clerk of this City in compliance with Section 50022 of the Government Code of this State.


Section 2. All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed in so far as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times and shall be in force and take effect on and after the first day of September, 1949.
