

ORDINANCE NO. 408

REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 168, AMENDING SECTION 13 OF ORDINANCE NO. 21, AND REGULATING THE STORAGE AND VENDING OF FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Repeal. Ordinance No. 168 is hereby repealed and Section 13 of Ordinance No. 21 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 13. Flammable Liquids. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to deliver any gasoline, distillate, fuel oils, benzine, naphtha, ether, coal-oil or any other flammable liquid having a flashpoint below two hundred degrees Fahrenheit, closed Cup Tester, in quantities of more than five gallons unless the same be delivered to and stored in tanks constructed and installed in accordance with "Standards of the National Board of Fire Underwriters for the Installation of Containers for Storing and Handling Flammable Liquids", revised reprint of September, 1948, adopted hereby as if set forth in full herein.

Flammable liquids of Class I and Class II, as the same are classified in the said "Standards of the National Board of Fire Underwriters", shall be delivered to the public from dispensing devices only by qualified, paid operators of said devices. When unattended, all pumps and other facilities for the delivery of such flammable liquids shall be locked or other effective provision shall be made to prevent public access to supplies of such flammable liquids."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.




