ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNEXATION  
OF "RALMAR ADDITION" TO THE CITY OF  
LODI, CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, This City Council of the City of Lodi did on the 15th day of March 1950, pass and adopt its Resolution of Intention No. 1516 declaring its intention to annex certain contiguous uninhabited territory in San Joaquin County to the City of Lodi pursuant to proceedings had and to be had conforming to the provisions of the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939", as amended, designating said territory "RALMAR ADDITION" as an appropriate designation for identification, and,

WHEREAS, said Resolution of Intention No. 1516 was published in full, in time, form and manner as provided by law as is evidenced by the affidavit of the principal clerk of the publisher of The Lodi Times, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Lodi, on file and of record in the office of the City Clerk of this City, and,

WHEREAS, Among other things, said Resolution No. 1516 contained a notice that this City Council had designated Wednesday, the 5th day of April, 1950, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. and the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Lodi, California, as the time and place when and where written protests or objections

to the annexation proposed would be received, heard and considered, and,

WHEREAS, At the said time and place this City Council did announce that it was then ready to receive and hear the objections of property owners in the territory proposed for annexation and no objections, written or oral were then presented, and, therefore, this City Council did then and there acquire jurisdiction to annex said territory to the City of Lodi, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The annexation of the following described territory in San Joaquin County, California, designated "RALMAR ADDITION", is hereby approved and the same shall be, from the effective date of this ordinance, annexed to and made part of the City of Lodi, to wit:

EACH LOTS 31 AND 38, MAP OF GERARD TRACT, MAP FILED AUGUST 8, 1916 IN BOOK OF MAPS, VOL. 8, PAGE 62, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY RECORDS, EXCEPT THEREFROM THE EASTERLY 110.7 FEET, BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID LOT 31, IN THE CENTER LINE OF CROSS STREET, THENCE EASTERLY ON THE NORTH LINE OF LOT 31 TO A POINT THEREON 110.7 FEET WESTERLY FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SAID LOT; THENCE SOUTHERLY, PARALLEL TO THE EAST LINE OF LOTS 31 AND 38 AND 110.7 FEET WESTERLY FROM THE EAST LINE OF SAID LOTS TO THE CENTER LINE


OF LOCKEFORD AVENUE; THENCE WESTERLY ON SAID CENTER LINE TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE CENTER LINE OF CROSS STREET (ALSO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID LOT 38); THENCE NORTHERLY ON THE CENTER LINE OF CROSS STREET 393.68 FEET TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 31 AND THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF THE TRACT OF LAND HEREIN PROPOSED FOR ANNEXATION; COWTAINING 3.5 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, EXCLUSIVE OF COUNTY ROADS.


Section 2. Upon the effective date of this ordinance, the City Clerk shall make, certify and transmit a certified copy thereof to the Secretary of State of the State of California, giving the date of its passage, adoption and approval and he shall also comply with such statutes as may be applicable hereto to effect the purposes hereof.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times, the official newspaper of the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect at the Limes herein and by law provided.
