ORDINANCE NO. 414

AMENDING THE ZONE DISTRICT MAP OF THE CITY OF LODI BY ALTERING THE ZONE BOUNDARY LINES DISPLAYED THEREON AND REZONING AND RECLASSIFYING A PORTION OF LOT 14, MAP NO. 1, LIVE OAK COLONY TO BE IN THE INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ZONE.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Zone District Map of the City of Lodi, adopted by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 238 (Zoning Ordinance) of this City, as amended, is hereby further amended and the property hereinafter described, reclassified and rezoned from its present classification, Multiple Family Residential District Zone to be in the Industrial District Zone, to wit:


LOT FOURTEEN (14) LIVE OAK COLONY MAP NO. 1 SAVE AND EXCEPT STATE HIGHWAY 24; SAVE AND EXCEPT THE WESTERLY 80 FEET AND THE SOUTHERLY 500 FEET OF SAID LOT 14 AND THAT PORTION OF SAID LOT NOW ZONED BY THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 317, SECTION (c) AS BEING IN THE INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ZONE.

The alterations, changes and amendments to said "Zone District Map" herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council after hearings held in conformity with the provisions of said Ordinance No. 238 and the laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, in so far as such conflict may exist, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times, the official newspaper of the City of Lodi and shall take effect thirty days from and after its final passage and approval.
