ORDINANCE NO. 424

ORDERING THE VACATION OF THE WEST TEN (10) FEET  
OF LOT FIFTEEN (15) IN SUBDIVISION OF BLOCK 10,  
LODI BARNHART TRACT AS A PUBLIC ALLEY.

WHEREAS, this City Council, acting in accordance with the provisions of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of this State, did, on the 21st day of June, 1950, pass and adopt its Resolution No. 1534 therein declaring the intention of said City Council to vacate, close up and abandon that portion of the ten foot wide alley conveyed to the City of Lodi by May C. Gammon by deed dated July 24, 1914, and recorded July 25, 1914, in Book "A" of Deeds, Vol. 250, Page 84, San Joaquin County Records, and,

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission of this City has approved such vacation, and,

WHEREAS, notices of such intention were regularly posted and published in time, form and manner required by law as appears from affidavits on file and of record in the office of the City Clerk of this City, and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with a provision in said Resolution No. 1534, also contained in the posted notices of the adoption thereof, a public hearing before said City Council was held on Wednesday, July 19, 1950, at which hearing no protests or objections to said alley vacation were received and from evidence offered,

this City Council did then find that said alley is unnecessary for present or prospective uses as a public street, save as an easement for public utilities to serve premises facing Central Avenue and abutting on the portion of alley proposed to be vacated, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following described public alley is hereby ordered vacated, closed up and abandoned as a public street or way, viz:

THE WEST TEN (10) FEET OF LOT NUMBER FIFTEEN (15) AS SAID LOT IS DELINEATED AND SO DESIGNATED ON THE OFFICIAL MAP ENTITLED "PLAT OF SUBDIVISION OF BLOCK 10, LODI BARNHART TRACT" ON FILE AND OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER OF SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, RESERVING TO THE CITY OF LODI, HOWEVER, AN EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES THEREIN TO SERVE PREMISES FRONTING ON CENTRAL AVENUE AND ABUTTING ON THE PORTION OF ALLEY HEREBY VACATED.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage. The City Clerk shall cause a certified copy hereof to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of San Joaquin County as required by Section 8324 of the Streets and Highways Code of this State.


