ORDINANCE NO. 452

AMENDING THE ZONE DISTRICT MAP OF THE CITY OF LODI AS ADOPTED BY SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 238 AND THEREBY REZONING AND RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN LOTS AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF CHURCH STREET AND FORREST AVENUE, PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN TO BE IN THE MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENCE DISTRICT ZONE.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Zone District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 238, as amended, is hereby further amended and the properties hereinafter described rezoned and reclassified from their present classification as being in the One and Two Family Residence District Zone to be in the MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENCE DISTRICT ZONE

BEGINNING ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF FORREST AVENUE AND NORTH CHURCH STREET; THENCE EASTERLY ALONG FORREST AVENUE 165 FEET TO AN ALLEY; SOUTH ON ALLEY 290 FEET; WEST TO NORTH ^{church} STREET; NORTH ALONG CHURCH-STREET 290 FEET TO BEGINNING.

The changes and amendment made herein are made after public hearings had before the City Planning Commission and the City Council of the City of Lodi in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 238 and laws of the State of California in such instances made and provided.


Section 2 All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith & hereby repealed in so far as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Lodi Times, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage,
