ORDINANCE NO. 512

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF  
THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING  
A PORTION OF LOT 27, LODI BARNHARDT  
TRACT, TO BE IN THE R-4 DISTRICT.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows :

Section 1. The Official District Map of the City of Lodi, adopted by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 469 (Zoning Ordinance) is hereby amended and the property hereinafter described reclassified and rezoned from its present classification as being in the R-3 Residence District to be in the R-4 Residence District, viz:

. Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 27 of the Lodi Barnhart Tract, going easterly along the north line of said lot to a point 130 feet, thence southerly and parallel to the west line 132 feet, thence easterly along a line parallel to the north line of said lot to a point 200 feet, thence southerly and parallel to said west line 132 feet, thence westerly and parallel to said north line 140 feet, thence southerly and parallel to said west line 132 feet to a point on the south line of said Lot 27.

The alterations, changes and amendments of said "Official District Map of the City of Lodi" herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearing held in conformance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 469 of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in so far as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News-Sentinel" and shall be in full force and take effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage and approval.
