ORDINANCE NO. 614

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF THE
CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING PROPERTY
ON THE WEST SIDE OF SOUTH STOCKTON STREET
TO BE IN THE M INDUSTRIAL ZONE

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 469 (Zoning Ordinance) is hereby amended and the property hereinafter described rezoned and reclassified from its present classification as being in the R-3 and R-4 Residential Districts to be in the M Industrial District, viz:

All that certain real property situate in the County of San Joaquin, State of California, described as follows, to wit:

Lots 60 through 68 inclusive, Lodi Barnhart Tract, as filed for record on November 5, 1906, in Volume 3, Page 48, Book of Maps and Plats, San Joaquin County Records, and excluding the westerly 250 feet thereof.

The alterations, changes and amendments of said "Official District Map of the City of Lodi" herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearing held in conformance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 469 of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in so far as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News-Sentinel" and shall be in full force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
