

ORDINANCE NO. 635

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.2 OF SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 579 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15 AND 20 AND REPEALING SECTION 21 OF ORDINANCE NO. 416 ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE CREATING A RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR CITY EMPLOYEES, ESTABLISHING A PEWSION FUND THEREFOR AND CREATING A PENSION BOARD'"

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 9.2 of Section 2 of Ordinance No. 579 is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

Section 9.2 Rates of Contribution - Police and Fire.

Rates of contribution for employees of the Police and Fire Departments not eligible for coverage in the Federal Old Age and Survivor's Insurance program shall be as prescribed in Section 9.1 hereof, plus two and one-half per cent ($2\frac{1}{2}\%$) of the first forty-eight hundred dollars (\$4800.00) of gross annual salary, exclusive of overtime. The matching requirements set forth in Section 10 hereof shall be met with respect to the total contributions made by such Police and Fire members.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time after its passage in the "Lodi News-Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect from and after February 1, 1959.
