

ORDINANCE NO. 654

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING LOTS 18 AND 19, STORRO TRACT, TO BE IN THE C-2 GENERAL COMMERCIAL ZONE.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 469 (Zoning Ordinance) is hereby amended and the property hereinafter described rezoned and reclassified from its present classification as being in the R-4 Multiple Family Residential District to be in the C-2 General Commercial District, viz:

Lots 18 and 19, Storro Tract, as filed for record on February 23, 1955.


The alterations, changes and amendments of said "Official District Map of the City of Lodi" herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearing held in conformance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 469 of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in so far as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News-Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in full force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
