ORDINANCE NO. 670

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LODI, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A REVISION AND CODIFICATION OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LODI, CALIFORNIA, ENTITLED "THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LODI, CALIFORNIA, 1959," PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN, WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET OUT.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby adopted by the City of Lodi, California, that certain Code entitled "The Code of the City of Lodi, California, 1959" containing certain ordinances of a general and permanent nature as compiled, consolidated, codified and indexed in the following chapters, namely, Chapters 1 to 27, both inclusive, of which Code not less than 3 copies have been and are now filed in the office of the City Clerk and which is hereby referred to and adopted by reference as if incorporated and set out at length in this ordinance.

Section 2. The provisions of such Code shall be in force on and after April 2, 1960, and all ordinances of a general and permanent nature in force on November 7, 1959, and not contained in such Code are hereby repealed from and after April 2, 1960, except as hereinafter provided.

Section 3. The repeal provided for in the preceding section of this ordinance shall not affect any offense or act committed or done or any penalty or forfeiture incurred or any contract or right established or accruing before April 2, 1960; nor shall such repeal affect any ordinance or resolution promising or guaranteeing the payment of money for the City or authorizing the issue of any bond of the City or any evidence of the City's indebtedness or any contract or obligation assumed by the City; nor shall such repeal affect the administrative ordinances or resolutions of the council

not in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of such Code; nor shall it affect the annual tax levy; nor shall it affect any right or franchise conferred by ordinance or resolution of the City on any person or corporation; nor shall it affect any ordinance relating to the salaries of the City's officers or employees; nor shall it affect any ordinance annexing territory to the City; nor shall it affect any ordinance naming, opening, accepting or vacating streets or alleys in the City; nor shall it affect Ordinance No. 606 establishing rates for the sale of electricity by the City, Ordinance Nos. 568 and 611 relating to the formation and regulation of Parking District No. 1 in the City, Ordinance No. 493, section 190 as amended by Ordinance No. 564, section 2 designating one-way streets and alleys, Ordinance No. 493, section 191 as amended by Ordinance No. 577, section 2 designating through streets, Ordinance No. 493, section 192 as amended by Ordinance No. 514, section 3 designating atop intersections, Ordinance No. 493, section 193 designating railroad stops, Ordinance No. 493, section 194 as amended by Ordinance No. 562, section 1 and Ordinance No. 593, section 1 designating angle parking on certain streets, Ordinance No. 493, section 195 as amended by Ordinance No. 523, section 4 designating parking time limitations on certain streets, Ordinance No. 493, section 196 designating certain streets on which parking is prohibited, Ordinance No. 493, section 197 designating truck routes, Ordinance No. 493, section 198 as amended by Ordinance No. 514, section 4 designating streets on which commercial trucks and vehicles are prohibited, Ordinance No. 493, section 199 designating alleys in which parking is permitted, Ordinance No. 493, section 201 as amended by Ordinance No. 516, section 2 increasing state speed limit in certain zones, Ordinance No. 63 regulating the waling of excavations in the City, and Ordinance No. 123 establishing grades, grade elevations and curb lines, etc., on certain streets in the City.

Section 4. That any violation of such Code shall, except as

may be specifically otherwise provided, be punishable by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not exceeding six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News-Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be, in force and take effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage.
