

ORDINANCE NO. 679

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY ON THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH CHURCH STREET BETWEEN LOUIE AVENUE AND TURNER ROAD TO BE IN THE R-3 LIMITED MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONE.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 469 (Zoning Ordinance) is hereby amended and the property hereinafter described rezoned and reclassified from its present classification as being in the R-2 One Family Residential District to be in the R-3 Limited Multiple Family Residential District, viz:

The East 175 feet of Blocks 5 and 6, Burr's Addition to Lodi, as filed for record on September 5, 1887 in Vol. 1 of Maps and Plats, page 4, San Joaquin County Records.

The alterations, changes and amendments of said "Official District Map of the City of Lodi" herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearing held in conformance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 469 of the City of Lodi and the Laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in so far as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in full force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
