

ORDINANCE NO. 718

AMENDING PARAGRAPH (e) OF SECTION 27-13 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY PERMITTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF CIVIL DEFENSE SHELTERS IN FRONT YARDS OR STREET SIDE YARDS SUBJECT TO ISSUANCE OF A USE PERMIT.

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added to paragraph (e) of Section 27-13 of the Code of the City of Lodi the following subparagraph:


"6. Civil defense shelters; provided, however, that a use permit shall be obtained before any such shelter may be located in a required front yard or street side yard. Said use permit shall limit the height of said structure, require adequate drainage, restrict utility connections thereto, and make such other conditions as may be necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the community."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News-Sentinel," a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage.
